I have read and understand the Elizabethtown Independent School District Acceptable Use Policy. I agree to abide by the guidelines of this policy. I acknowledge that:

- ❖ The district's computer and telecommunications assets are provided for educational purposes only. They will not be used for personal business, political lobbying, or product advertisement.
- ❖ I will practice proper etiquette on the network.
- ❖ The display, receipt, or transmission of inappropriate language, pictures, or material of any kind is a violation of this policy.
- ❖ I must adhere to all copyright policies.
- ❖ I (or my parents/guardians) am responsible for any expenses I incur while using the network.
- ❖ All telecommunication sessions are the "property" of the district and may be read by the system administrator.
- ❖ Intentional violation of these rules will result in loss of network privileges as well as other possible disciplinary or legal action.
- ❖ This agreement is legally binding and must be filed with the School Technology Coordinator prior to the user receiving network access.
- ❖ Schools may elect to use blocking and/or tracking software on computers, however, the responsibility for adherence to these guidelines rests solely with the user.
- ❖ All students will log on using authorized user name and password.
- ❖ No food, drinks, gum or candy will be permitted in the lab.
- ❖ Do not change desktop settings, including: icons, resolution, sound, and Internet home page.
- ❖ Do not remove labels or stickers from the computer.
- ❖ No printing is permitted.
- ❖ No downloading of any kind.
- ❖ No software installation or account creation.
- ❖ No email, chat, or instant messaging.
- ❖ No moving the monitors.
