



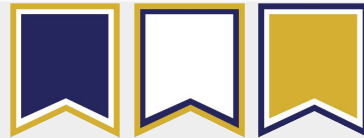
COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Re: Positive COVID case - To be communicated via Infinite Campus

Dear Parent(s) / Guardian(s),

This is to inform you that on (DATE) _____,

We were notified that a student in one of your child's classrooms tested positive for COVID-19.

We ask that you monitor your child for any symptoms and if they begin to experience symptoms within 10 days, we ask you to keep your student home and consult your physician or school nurse.

If your child or any household member has been tested for COVID and awaiting lab results - please **DO NOT** send your child back to school until **NEGATIVE** COVID results are confirmed. If results are positive for your child or a household member, please keep your child at **HOME** and notify your student's school immediately.

Continue to monitor your child for illness every day and keep your child at home if they are sick. Please contact your healthcare provider and your student's school if your child develops symptoms or if you have any additional questions or concerns.

To excuse absences a doctor's note must be provided. At home tests will not be accepted as a way to excuse the absence.
